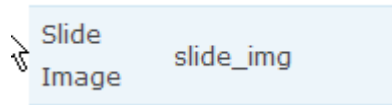


I've created a content type called: slide\_img

I've setup the jcarousel module:

### jCarousel Block

**image field name:** \*

The block will read the images from the field name e.g. imceimage, imagefield, filefield, etc. Currently c

**image source type:** \*

▽ **imceimage specific settings**

▽ **directoryimage option specific settings**

The settings here only take effect when the directoryimage option is used

**image directory pattern:**

## Carousel block

### Block specific settings

#### Block title:

Override the default title for the block. Use `<none>` to display no title.

### User specific visibility settings

#### Custom visibility settings:

- Users cannot control whether or not they see this block.
- Show this block by default, but let individual users hide it.
- Hide this block by default but let individual users show it.

Allow individual users to customize the visibility of this block in their user profile.

### Role specific visibility settings

#### Show block for specific roles:

- anonymous user
- authenticated user

Show this block only for the selected role(s). If you select no roles, the block will be visible to all users.

### Page specific visibility settings

#### Show block on specific pages:

- Show on every page except the listed pages.
- Show on only the listed pages.
- Show if the following PHP code returns TRUE (PHP-mustache only).
